

31 Days of Prayer: Week 1

<p>Sunday SALVATION</p>	<p>Salvation – John 3:16 <i>For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.</i> Prayer Points: Salvation and/or a deeper personal relationship with Jesus</p>
<p>Monday LOVE</p>	<p>Love – I John 4:7-8 <i>Beloved, let us love one another: for love is of God; and everyone that loveth is born of God, and knoweth God. He that loveth not knoweth not God: for God is love.</i> Prayer Points: To know God’s unconditional love personally and to practice pure Christ-like love in relationships</p>
<p>Tuesday GRACE</p>	<p>Grace – Ephesians 1:6 <i>To the praise of the glory of his grace, wherein he hath made us accepted in the beloved.</i> Prayer Points: To experience God’s grace personally and to exercise gracefulness toward others</p>
<p>Wednesday MERCY</p>	<p>Mercy – Luke 6:36 <i>Be ye therefore merciful, as your Father also is merciful.</i> Prayer Points: To understand God’s mercy more and more each day and to be merciful to others</p>
<p>Thursday FORGIVENESS</p>	<p>Forgiveness – I John 1:9 <i>If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.</i> Prayer Points: To recognize and confess sin quickly; to forgive others and not hold grudges or allow bitterness to take root</p>
<p>Friday KINDNESS</p>	<p>Kindness – Ephesians 4:32 <i>And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ’s sake hath forgiven you.</i> Prayer Points: To be sensitive to others by exhibiting compassion, love and forgiveness</p>
<p>Saturday TRUST</p>	<p>Trust – Proverbs 3:5-6 <i>Trust in the Lord with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths.</i> Prayer Points: To let go of control and completely trust God’s divine will no matter what</p>
