## 31 Days of Prayer: Week 1

Sunday SALVATION	Salvation – John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. Prayer Points: Salvation and/or a deeper personal relationship with Jesus
Monday LOVE	Lovg – I John 4:7-8  Beloved, let us love one another: for love is of God; and everyone that loveth is born of God, and knoweth God. He that loveth not knoweth not God; for God is love.  Prayer Points: To know God's unconditional love personally, and to practice pure Christ-like love in relationships
Tuesday GRACE	Grace – Ephesians 1:6  To the praise of the glory of his grace, wherein he hath made us accepted in the beloved.  Prayer Points: To experience God's grace personally and to exercise gracefulness toward others
Wødnøsday MERCY	Morey – Luke 6:36  Be ye therefore merciful, as your Father also is merciful.  Prayer Points: To understand God's mercy poured out on the cross and to be merciful to others
Thursday FORGIVENESS	Forgiveness – I John 1:9  If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.  Prayer Points: To recognize and be sensitive to sin; to forgive others and not hold grudges or allow bitterness to take root
Friday KINDNESS	Kindness – Ephesians 4:32  And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.  Prayer Points: To be sensitive to others by showing compassion, love and forgiveness
Saturday TRUST	Trust — Proverbs 3:5-6  Trust in the Lord with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths.  Prayer Points: To let go and completely trust God's divine will no matter what
