

God-Centered Prayer: Week 3

<p>Sunday MY COMFORT</p>	<p>My Comfort – Psalm 23:4 <i>Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for thou art with me: thy rod and they staff thy comfort me.</i> Prayer Points: Acknowledge God's comfort. Think about when you have experienced His comfort. Tell Him how thankful you are for His comfort.</p>
<p>Monday MY HOPE</p>	<p>My Hope – Romans 15:13 <i>Now the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that ye may abound in hope, through the power of the Holy Ghost.</i> Prayer Points: Acknowledge God's hope through the Holy Spirit. Think about the peace and joy that God gives. Thank God for the blessed hope that we have as His children.</p>
<p>Tuesday MY HELP</p>	<p>My Help – Psalm 121:2 <i>My help cometh from the Lord, which made heaven and earth.</i> Prayer Points: Acknowledge God's help beyond any help on this earth. Think about the way He helps in hard times. Thank Him for the way He has helped you in your life.</p>
<p>Wednesday MY STRENGTH</p>	<p>My Strength – Psalm 138:3 <i>In the day when I cried thou answered me, and strengthened me with strength in my soul.</i> Prayer Points: Acknowledge God's strength beyond any human strength. Think about how His strength has held you up in the past. Tell Him how thankful you are for His strength.</p>
<p>Thursday MY REFUGE</p>	<p>My Refuge – Psalm 46:1 <i>God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble.</i> Prayer Points: Acknowledge God as your refuge. Think about when you have needed a safe place to go. Tell Him how amazing it is to have a safe place to take your fears, heartaches and pain.</p>
<p>Friday MY LORD FOREVER</p>	<p>My Lord Forever – Psalm 102:12 <i>But thou, O Lord, shalt endure forever; and thy remembrance unto all generations.</i> Prayer Points: Acknowledge God as your one and only Lord forever. Think about how you can elevate Him in your life to take first place in all things. Tell Him how you much you desire Him to be Lord in every part of your life.</p>
<p>Saturday MY SATISFACTION</p>	<p>My Satisfaction – Matthew 6:33 <i>But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.</i> Prayer Points: Acknowledge God as your priority in all things. Think about ways to elevate Him more. Thank Him for filling the void in your heart. If you are struggling, ask Him to satisfy your soul.</p>
