God-Centered Prayer: Week 4

Sunday God's SOVEREIGNTY	God's Sovereignty – Romans 8:28 And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose. Prayer Points: Acknowledge God's sovereign hand in all things. Think about how He sees and knows everything. Tell Him how amazing it is that He is in all and over all.
Monday God's MERCY	God's Morcy – Ephesians 2:4 But God, who is rich in mercy, for his great love wherewith he us. Prayer Points: Acknowledge God's amazing mercy. Think about how His mercy impacts your life. Thank Him for being merciful to you.
Tuesday God's TIMING	God's Timing – Ecclesiastes 3:1 <i>To everything there is a season, and a time for every purpose under the heaven.</i> Prayer Points: Acknowledge God's perfect timing in all things. Think about how God has orchestrated things in your life. Tell Him how amazing His timing is and thank Him for it.
Wednesday God's WISDOM	God's Wisdom – James 3:17 But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, and easy to be entreated, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality, and without hypocrisy. Prayer Points: Acknowledge God as the source of wisdom. Think about how His wisdom can impact your life. Tell Him how much you desire His wisdom and thank Him for the gift of communication with Him.
Thursday God's WILL	God's Will – Jeremiah 29:11 For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the Lord, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end. Prayer Points: Acknowledge God's will. Think about the peace that He desires for you. Tell Him how much you desire His will and submit to His peace.
Friday God's PROVIDENCE	God's Providence – Proverbs 3:6 In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths. Prayer Points: Acknowledge God's providence. Think about He has worked things out in your life. Tell Him that you trust Him no matter what.
<mark>Saturday</mark> God's GLORY	God's Glorg – I Chronicles 29:11a <i>Thine, O Lord is the greatness, and the power, and the glory, and the victory, and the majesty: for all that</i> <i>is in the heaven and in the earth.</i> Prayer Points: Acknowledge God's glory. Think about how His glory is revealed to you. Give Him glory with your words.
